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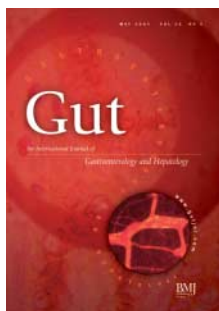
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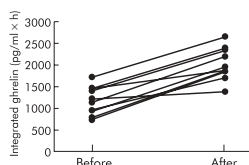
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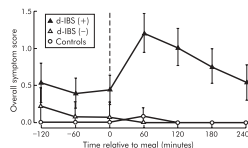
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Immunoreactivity with an achalasia serum sample (from the paper by Moses *et al*, pp 629–36).

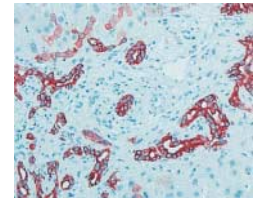

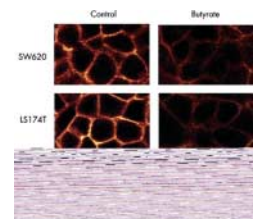

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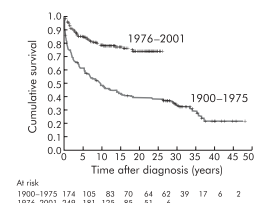
